That there is a distinction between 'public' and 'private' seems self-evident. Yet the issues of why, how and to what effect we distinguish between public and private are much less frequently discussed.

This two-day conference will explore our manifold ways of making such distinctions by focusing on the complex relationships between the urban and the domestic realms. Its concern is to examine the ways in which the interactions between private and public, urban and domestic, are manifested in architectural and urban form and through other structures of representation.
